K - Step 9

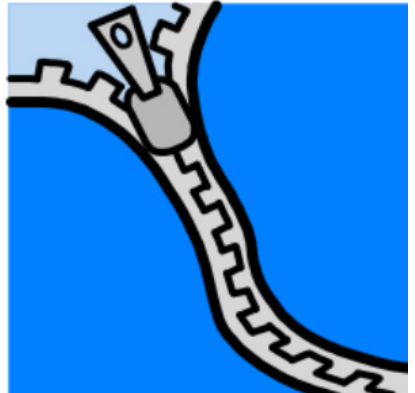
Use 1 sentence as an example:

Use 1 sentence as an example:

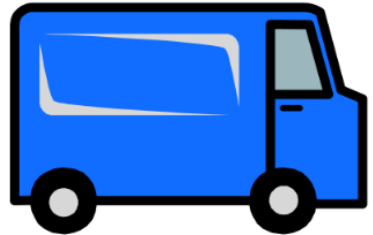
Van (point to the picture)

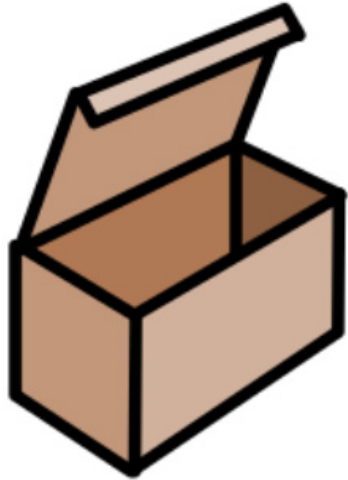
Use 1 sentence as an example:

Use 1 sentence as an example:

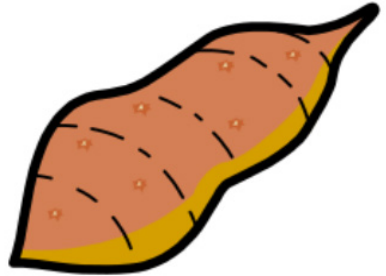
I like to eat **yams**.

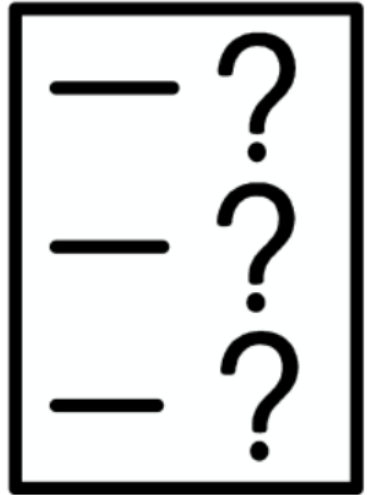

Use 1 sentence as an example:

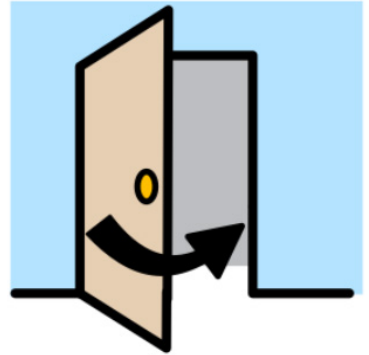
shut (with action)

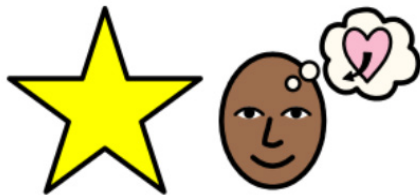
Use 1 sentence as an example:

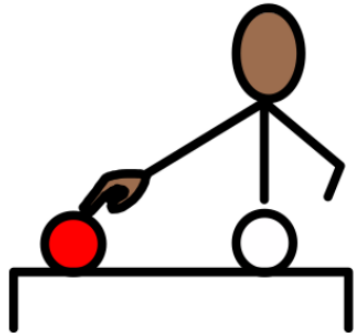
